		 Council has been advised that a CCTV survey shows a blockage at a bend in the surface water pipe under the property, which is believed to be a trapped sandbag. Council suggests that a manhole cover is installed at this point in the pipe to enable removal of the obstruction and improve the water flow around an acute angle. Council believes that this all needs to be shown within a drainage plan. The flow of water needs to be established by the CCTV company as council believe the watercourse runs from behind South Gables and then downhill towards the Ock passing under Hughes Crescent and into the ditch in front of Wellington. Council requests that Leigh Travis studies the CCTV and comments so that the applicants can submit a drainage plan as per the requests of Council on every application, especially in such circumstances with the history of this plot. The drainage route plan that has been submitted on the application is incorrect and shows for instance a soakaway and not a manhole. Council would await the outcome of Highways on the new vehicular access and whether it fits with both legal and practical outcomes and request that any access should not block access to the manholes to the water course that runs beneath, which must be shown within the drainage plan when submitted. Please ensure that neighbours are now satisfied with the drop in height of the structure and the placement of any new windows and roof lights.
